
Mixed Media for Mini Artists

Digital Art for Beginners


Wednesdays, January 7 to March 11 (10 Weeks) Ages 8 to 12 | 4 to 6 PM | \$361

Thursdays, February 5 to April 2* (8 Weeks) 10 AM to 12:30 PM | Ages 18+ | \$394





Weekend Workshops for Adults

Brush Calligraphy: Beginners Sundays, January 25 and March 1 1 to 4 PM | Ages 16+ | \$60 each

Learn the fundamentals of modern brush calligraphy, including how to hold a brush pen, form basic strokes, and connect them to form lowercase letters and words. Hand Lettered Valentine's Day Cards

Painting with Fibre

Sculpting with Fibre

Learn how to transform soft wool fibres into sculptural vessels in this wet felting workshop. Using water, soap, and friction, you'll explore the traditional flat resist method to create a unique vase or bowl. Perfect for all level felters, this workshop guides you through shaping, texturing, and decorating your piece. Artist/Instructor: Rumy Glogova

Acrylic Pouring
