Start with Art!

Ages 4 to 5 | 10 AM to 12 PM Saturdays, October 4 to December 6 | \$361 for 10 sessions

Bring your creative genius to the Varley to unlock their imagination in a fun and inclusive environment. Children will be introduced to the vibrant world of color through engaging drawing, painting, and sculpting projects. This program emphasizes the fundamentals of art, including colour mixing and creative process, while encouraging self-expression and cooperation. Children will also develop their coordination and fine motor skills along the way. All materials included.







Art Explorers

Ages 5 to 6 | 1 PM to 3 PM Saturdays, October 4 to December 6 | \$361 for 10 sessions

This is the perfect program for any young artist eager to play and learn in a fun and creative studio setting. Children are encouraged to develop their artistic abilities while exploring painting techniques and working with both traditional and non-traditional materials. They'll also visit the gallery for inspiration, sparking their creativity and deepening their understanding of art. This approach inspires them to try new things, make new friends, and learn valuable skills like collaboration, problem-solving, and creative expression. All materials included.







Elements of Art and Design

Ages 7 to 10 | 10 AM to 12 PM Saturdays, October 4 to December 6 | \$361 for 10 sessions

Are you ready to challenge your child to explore their imagination in a creative and supportive studio setting? Our professional artist-instructor will guide your child through the elements and principles of art and design, encouraging experimentation and self-discovery, which are essential for developing critical thinking and observational skills. Children will learn how to properly use tools and techniques to create finished drawings, watercolour and acrylic paintings, prints, and a mixed-media piece. Studio discussions, gallery visits, and artist demonstrations are integral components of this program in order for all children to create works they'll be proud to showcase at an end of term art show. Sculpture Studio

Art Portfolio Development

DIY Printmaking Studio

Fridays, October 3 to October 24 | 1 PM to 3:30 PM | \$197 for 4 sessions

Discover the creative possibilities of printmaking, no press required! This engaging workshop series introduces participants to a variety of accessible, low-cost printmaking techniques that can be done right at home using everyday and recycled materials. From kitchen lithography to linocut carving and beyond, you'll learn step-by-step methods to create layered, textured, and dynamic prints while exploring composition, colour, and design. Perfect for beginners and creative enthusiasts alike, this series is a great way to build skills, experiment with new materials, and unlock your artistic potential in a supportive, at-studio setting. Watercolour: Beginner to Intermediate

Introduction to Drawing

Landscape Painting

Explore topics such as oil painting safety, composition, value, and design, as well as focused lessons on how to paint the sky, trees, clouds, buildings, shrubs, flowers, and more. With step-by-step instructor guidance and critiques, this course is suitable for both beginner and seasoned landscape painters. Materials not included. Acrylic Pouring: Beginner to Advanced Techniques

Thursdays, October 2 to November 27 (No class on October 9) 1 PM to 3:30 PM | \$394 for 8 sessions

Discover the magic of acrylic pouring in this dynamic class designed for all skill levels. Whether you're just starting out or looking to refine your technique, this course will guide you through the fundamentals and explore more advanced methods like the chain pull, bloom, and Dutch pour. Learn about colour theory, composition, mixing mediums, and how to create stunning abstract artworks with movement and depth. Materials not included. Intro to Acrylics: Painting for Pleasure

Fridays, October 3 to November 21 10 AM to 12:30 PM | \$394 for 8 sessions

Whether you are new to painting or returning to your practice, this course is a great way to relax and enjoy the painting process. Work in acrylics on paper and canvas along side the instructor as she guides you through beginner techniques to create landscapes, portraits, and still-life paintings from reference images. No experience required. Materials not included.

Intro to Portrait Drawing: Beginner to Intermediate

Fridays, October 3 to November 21 10 AM to 12:30 PM | \$394 for 8 sessions

Discover the art of Portraiture! We will focus on the fundamentals of portraiture to understand the construction of the face and head by using a simple step-by-step drawing method. Next, we will use shading to create value and form, and together we will work towards capturing a likeness while drawing a professional model. Suitable for all skill levels. Materials not included.

The Painted Portrait: Advanced

Simplify your portraiture palette and learn the art of mixing skin tones with only 3 colours + white in this advanced portrait painting course. Using the "zorn" palette we will explore an easy system to quickly and accurately mix warm and cool flesh tones in oil or acrylic paint. Topics include brush drawing, mixing accurate skin tones, layering paint, and capturing a likeness while working from a professional model. Materials not included.

Brush Calligraphy: Beginner Ages 16+ | Sunday, September 28 | 1 PM to 4 PM | \$60

Brush pen calligraphy is a beautiful art form that can be used to add a personal touch to everything from greeting cards to event signage. In this three-hour workshop, students will learn the fundamentals of modern brush pen calligraphy, including how to hold a brush pen, how to form basic strokes and how to connect these strokes to form lowercase letters and words. Students will receive a set of worksheets that they can take home to continue their practice. No experience is needed, just a willingness to have fun and try something new! Materials not included.

Brush Calligraphy: Intermediate

Ages 16+ | Sunday, November 23 | 1 PM to 4 PM | \$60

This class is designed for anyone who has taken a beginner-level brush pen calligraphy class and is ready to take their skills to the next level. In this three-hour workshop, students will practice uppercase letters and learn how to use these in combination with lowercase letters and words. They will also learn how to enhance their calligraphy by experimenting with style variations and simple flourishes. Students will receive a set of worksheets that they can take home to continue their practice. Materials not included.

The Joy of Handwriting

Custom ornaments make a wonderful gift for friends and family! In this two-hour workshop, students will learn how to draw beautiful script letters and use them to decorate their own acrylic ornaments. Students will leave the workshop with their finished ornaments as well as a set of worksheets to continue their hand lettering practice at home. All materials will be provided (e.g. ornaments, markers and ribbons). A supply fee of \$15 will need to be paid to the instructor at the start of the workshop.


